Since retiring from the fields, I have attended free of charge professionally all sick soldiers, together with the families of many soldiers within the bound of my practice.

In consideration of the premises, I ask that your Excellency grant me a detail for the ensuing year or so long as you should think such detail may conserve the public interest to pursue my practice upon the terms and considerations I am now doing, & your petitioner will soon ask &c.
