Will you also be so good as to ask Mr. Hart to look among the bundle of papers belonging to my department and take away from Columbia, and take from them an account enclosed in a small white envelope directed "W. S. Smith Secretary & Treasurer of Lunatic Asylum of Columbia". If he can find it, enclose it in an envelope directed to me here.

The Governor went to Columbia this morning but as he did not communicate to me any thing relative to his plans or movements, I cannot give you any information whatever.
