

Anderson, C. H. Sober,  
April 18<sup>th</sup> 1865

My Dear Sir:

This is to ask a favor at  
Your hands. My Son Aristide S. Romilla  
for whom I made application about two  
years ago, to enter the Arsenal Academy,  
did not meet with appointment at the last  
Meeting of the Board of Commissioners in  
December last, His application was renewed  
at that time, by our friends the Hon. Wm. J.  
Porter, and Mr. P. O'Connor Esq., at my  
request; and is now one of the first of  
applicants on the Beneficiary list. I heard  
that the next Legislature had in contemplation  
the Act of authorizing the Governor to admit  
all former applicants; - if this should not  
be the case, I would ask of your Excellency  
the favor of transferring my Son from  
the Late Militia Capt. Hall's Company  
40<sup>th</sup> Regt. where he is now enrolled, from

this place, and has been doing duty since  
December last; to the Cadet Battalion, until  
such time as he might get his appointment
