

Muir - v. Lee L.C.

25 Feb. 1865

General.

I wish to express to you by the return of the carrier a great pleasure you wish that you have done in the prosecution of the War with which you were charged.

The course of military operations has destroyed all communication. A carrier line will be established from New Orleans to Lancaster. So that point you will send all communications you may have to make. You will please notify those who may have communications to make, that if sent to Lancaster they will be forwarded. H. G. Billings Esq at Lancaster will be charged with the duty of receiving & forwarding such communications.

You will advise carrier lines through your sections of the State having the terminus of your carrier line at Lancaster.
