His Excellency W J Magrath
Governor

Mr P B Jenkins, a bonded Agri-
-culturist, now in the service of the State by your order, has obtain-
-ed a furlough to enable him to remove his negro and then he
has no charge for others (about One hundred and eighty) from
the low country to the interior of the State. He finds it im-
-possible to procure lands ready settled, and applies to you
for further time, that he may make the necessary arrange-
-ments for planting and cultivating a crop the ensuing season
I am sufficiently acquainted with the circumstances of
this case, to be able to say, that it is one of most urgent ne-
-cessity to Mr Jenkins & others, and of considerable importance
to the State
