

Society Hill April 2 1865

To His Excellency Gov Magrath

Sir

I have this day had information which I think reliable that on last Saturday three thousand troops (mostly negroes) with a Battery of Artillery landed in Georgetown with the avowed object of a raid to collect provisions for Sherman's Army, One source of the information points to Kingstree another to the Waccamaw and another to this part of the Pee Dee as the object of the raid, The Militia of this County has been organized but we are without arms and ammunition, Can they be supplied or can you send some of the first class Militia to Williamsburg & vicinity
